Standard Affiliate Membership **\$372**

Businesses or organizations that are involved in services related to campus activities or the purchase of entertainment without the intent of resale to colleges and universities, and which are not eligible for school or associate memberships, may be eligible for regular affiliate membership (e.g., private industries, cruise lines, military bases, preparatory or secondary schools, etc.). Regular affiliate membership includes up to three subscriptions to *Campus Activities Programming* magazine and access to and listing in the NACA Online Directory. \$95 of the affiliate membership goes toward a one-year subscription to *Campus Activities Programming*, based on a subscription cost of \$95 per year. This portion of the fee is not optional. Affiliate members can participate in conferences, festivals, the National Convention and Block Booking. Exhibiting is allowed, but not required. A firm that engages in selling goods or services to school members cannot be a regular affiliate member.

Purchase orders are accepted for standard affiliates only, and must be paid within 30 days of invoice in order to retain active membership status. Purchase requisitions or check requests will not be accepted.

Non-Profit Affiliate Membership **\$240**

Non-profit organizations whose services, products and programs are related to campus activities programming may be eligible for non-profit affiliate membership. Organizations must be designated by the Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation and provide education, resource services and/or opportunities for professional development. In addition, organizations cannot lobby for political issues or legislative change. Non-profit affiliate membership includes one subscription to *Campus Activities Programming* magazine and access to and listing in the NACA Online Directory. \$95 of the non-profit affiliate membership fee goes toward a one-year subscription to *Campus Activities Programming*, based on a subscription cost of \$95 per year. This portion of the fee is not optional. Non-profit affiliate members may attend the National Convention, regional conferences and festivals as exhibitors, following all applicable associate member policies regarding the purchase of booth space and delegate fees. Non-profit affiliate members are not eligible to showcase.

By submitting this application, I agree to read, and the organization I represent agrees to follow, the current versions of all rules, regulations, policies and procedures of the Association, including the NACA Process for Dealing with Violations of Association Policy. Such rules, regulations, policies and procedures may be amended by NACA's Board of Directors from time to time without notice and are available for review upon request.

I also agree that all legal claims relating to or arising from membership in NACA, fees assessed by NACA, participation in events sponsored by NACA, the policies of NACA, enforcement, application, and interpretation of NACA policies, disciplinary investigations, proceedings, and actions taken by NACA, and termination of membership in NACA, shall be resolved through binding arbitration. The arbitration shall be conducted in Columbia, South Carolina, pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association in effect on the date this application is signed, by one arbitrator appointed in accordance with such rules. Each party will bear its own attorneys' fees and costs, and will divide equally the costs of the arbitration. The arbitrator shall apply the law of the State of South Carolina to all matters brought before him/her. Any arbitration award shall be limited to actual damages only, and no award shall be made in excess of \$10,000. No punitive or enhanced damages, or pre-judgment interest, shall be awarded. All awards of the arbitration will be binding and non-appealable except as otherwise provided in the Federal Arbitration Act, 9 U.S.C. § 1, et seq. Judgment upon any award rendered by the arbitrator may be entered and enforced in any court having jurisdiction thereof. This arbitration provision applies only to legal claims, as described above. Internal disciplinary procedures conducted pursuant to NACA policies are not subject to arbitration.
